AND OTHER NON-CPC RELATED ISSUES ALSO**

**SWRC MODEL TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN SPIRIT  
IN OTHER PRINCIPAL CCITs JURISDICTIONS ALSO**

The President Samir S. Jani, Hon. Secretary Dhruven V.Shah, alongwith the Chairman, Mukesh M. Patel and Co-Chairman, Upendra J. Bhatt and Latesh K. Parikh of the Legal and Representation Committee of the Federation, met the Principal CCIT, Ahmedabad, Shri S.K. Ray and Additional CIT (HQ) Shri Rajesh Kumar to represent in regard to the rejuvenation of the Single Window Refund Cell (SWRC), which has been in slumber for quite some time.

It was pointed out to them that this joint initiative undertaken by the Department in co-operation with AGFTC and its constituent member associations in 2011 had received overwhelming response. Moreover, this Gujarat model was acclaimed all over the country, more particularly in the context of resolving the critical issues pursuant to the directions of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the PIL filed before it.

Both the authorities, not only gave a patient hearing, but also agreed with the demand for rejuvenation of the SWRC at the earliest. Infact, they accepted in principle that the most effective manner of resolving the CPC related grievances in relation to adjustment of refunds against grossly erroneous demands was through the smooth and effective functioning of the SWRC mechanism. It was also reiterated that as per the earlier setup, SWRC should also attend to the non-CPC related grievances in regard to non-receipt or short receipt of refunds.

The Proformas for filing applications before the SWRC in cases of CPC related and non-CPC related issues are duly attached herewith as separate Annexures. These Proformas can be used in respect of all taxpayers falling under the jurisdiction of the Principal CCIT, Ahmedabad, which includes Ahmedabad, Gandhinagar and the entire North Gujarat, as per the earlier arrangement. The applications will be accepted at the special SWRC Counter at the ground floor of Aaykar Bhavan, Ahmedabad.

It was also earnestly requested that similar arrangement for redressal of taxpayer grievances may be initiated under the other Principal CCIT jurisdictions at Rajkot, Baroda and Surat. In this regard, it was assured that this request will be conveyed to the respective authorities for effective implementation in a manner that the spirit of the SWRC model is adhered to.
